**If you show up without the following, you'll wish you'd have brought them!**

- For Bear Hunts, Ankle fit HIP boots with air bob soles a must. Either Cabela's Ultimate Contour Ankle (CC-83-0182) or Lacrosse Air Bob Soles, Insulated at (907)563-8600.
- For Mt. Goat hunts only! Schnee's insulated boots air grip soles Mid calf, 1-800-922-1562
- Heavy Duty Impertech or Gortex Rain gear. Both pants and top. Something that will not tear easily and is breathable. Helly Hansen Impertech (sold thru Cabela's) or Cabela's Rainy River Gore-Tex Gear are good choices.
- Wool or Whip Chord Hunting Pants.
- At least 2 pr. Of Capilene or Polypropylene Underwear. No Cotton!
- Long sleeve wool hunting jacket or mid weight pile jacket.
- Heavy jacket. You'll more than likely wear your pile jacket, heavy jacket AND rain gear in a layered system.
- Wool Sweater
- Wool socks or heavy socks.
- A good bomber style hat with ear protection or a hunting hat.
- 1 pair of wool gloves, 1 pair of polypro liners, and 2 pairs of Gortex heavy duty gloves (ski gloves). They tend to get wet fast, but these will keep you warm.
- Sunglasses
- Insect Repellent and head nets.
- Rifle (Brown Bear: .375 H & H Magnum or larger, using a 300 grain bullet) (Black Bear and MT. Goat 300, or 7mm) With hard case, and TWO boxes of Ammo.
- Binoculars.
- Gun Oil, rags, and rod.
- Flashlight, camera, extra film & batteries. We have a generator on board to recharge your video camera batteries.
